REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION FOR GSP APPLICANTS

*Applicants must bring one of the following along with current ID:
(All income verification must be current)*

- One month's check stub—it **MUST** be current.*
(Ex. If you get paid every 2 weeks or every 15 days we will need 2 check stubs
Ex. If you get paid every week then we will need 4 check stubs)

Note: If you get paid in cash, please bring a letter from your employer*. Included in the letter there must be an address, telephone number, the name of the business and/or company and your employer's full name. Also, the letter **MUST** be *notarized* by a **NotaryPublic**.

- **If applicant is unemployed.**
You must provide an Unemployment Statement of Benefits, from the Unemployment Department, indicating your Benefit Amounts.
- **If unemployed, but you Do Not receive benefits from Unemployment.**
You must provide an Unemployment Statement of non-benefits, along with the income and ID of the person(s) who provides financial assistance during your unemployment.
- **If Self-Employed**
You must provide your 1099 along with all other Tax Forms.
- Social Security Check Stub or Statement*
- Public Assistance Award Letter*
- Other proof of Income*
- ***Need both the 1044 and W2 If submitting tax forms for income verification.***

*Please bring (2) forms of ID for each member listed on application (ie. **Driver's License, State ID, Social Security Card, Birth Certificate, or Medicaid card**) along with a photo ID for students.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

If in the list of family members on the Good Samaritan Application there are family members 18 years old and above we will also need their proof of income. If the dependent child is a student over the age of 18 we will need proof of student status.
